- h) USTM and D. H. S. KANOI COMMERCE COLLEGE will jointly associate for academic collaboration in ICT, Counseling, Training etc. for teachers, staff and students from time to time.
- i) USTM and D. H. S. KANOI COMMERCE COLLEGE will jointly organize awareness campaigns, rallies, streetplays etc. on relevant and burning issues, celebrate important occasions and appreciate good works by offering felicitation to the performers from time to time.
- j) USTM and D. H. S. KANOI COMMERCE COLLEGE will extend support to the people in distress during any natural calamity of the region e.g. flood, earthquake, landslides etc.

Assam Startup – The Nest, GNB Road, Ambari, Guwahati 781001 and it's affiliates, hereinafter together shall be referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**".

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1. Background and Purpose:

a) Background:

The Assam Government has launched the Assam Startup Policy to promote entrepreneurship and the growth of startup culture in the state. To implement the policy, the Government has recently initiated the "Assam Startup" program, which aims to catalyze the startup movement in the state by motivating the youth to become job creators and providing necessary ecosystem support so that they may pursue their entrepreneurial dreams. A key element in this program is the state incubation center named "Assam Startup - The Nest", at Guwahati. The Assam Startup - The Nest is conceptualized as the hub for entrepreneurship development in the state and would facilitate district level entrepreneurship development with the support of the entrepreneurship development centers or incubators located within the institutes across the state. The Government has invited IIMCIP to be a knowledge partner for the initiative and manage the operations of the Assam Startup - The Nest.

b) The Objective:

This engagement will support the objectives mentioned in the Assam Startup Policy:

- a) Create a state-wide inclusive entrepreneurial ecosystem;
- b) Promote entrepreneurship, create awareness, and motivate the youth;
- c) Provide physical and virtual incubation services;
- d) Create 1000 startups in 5 years time;
- e) Create 1 lakh direct and indirect employment;
- f) Facilitate External Funding for startups.

2. Understanding between the two Parties

- a) Both parties acknowledge the need to create an ecosystem for promoting innovation and entrepreneurship and are interested in partnering to further this cause.
- b) There is a need to inculcate an entrepreneurial/problem-solving mindset among the students.
- c) Both parties understand and shall strive towards creating a support structure within an academic institution, so that students can nurture innovative entrepreneurial ideas.

3. Roles and Responsibilities of Assam Startup – The Nest:

- a) Assam Startup Nest shall facilitate creation of a network of Entrepreneurship Development Cells and Competency Centers located within the academic institutions.
- b) Promote and facilitate the setting up of Entrepreneurship Development Cells within the academic institutions which do not have one.
- c) Carry out capacity building of Entrepreneurship Development Cell personnel under "Train the Trainer" program, free of cost.

- d) Conduct district level Outreach events to promote entrepreneurship at the grassroots level.
- e) Conduct Networking meets for the Academic Partners to facilitate interaction between the institutions and leverage the strength of each other.
- f) Conduct state level B-Plan Contest / Startup Hunt for start-ups.
- g) Provide Incubation support (physical / virtual) to advanced level startups selected through the contests / hunts.
- h) Provide access to common resources like mentors, experts, and investors.

4. Responsibilities of Academic Partner:

The Academic Partner (AP) shall,

- a) Create a formal Entrepreneurship Development Cell or leverage existing Entrepreneurship Development Cell / Incubator to conduct Entrepreneurship Awareness and Motivation workshops / talks to encourage students to participate in entrepreneurship related activities.
- b) Help in conducting Outreach programs within the respective districts.
- c) Conduct Hackathons or ideation events to encourage students to come up with ideas.
- d) Provide support to the students with innovative ideas.
- e) Organize an Annual conference and Business plan contest to identify and recognize the budding entrepreneurs.
- f) Facilitate student interaction with startups.
- g) Make best efforts to support startups from the region with knowledge and access to resources (e.g. incubation facility, technology labs), so that innovative ideas can be transformed into successful business ventures.
- h) Take care of the expenses for conducting the internal programs or contests.
- i) Take care of the cost of travel, boarding, and lodging (if applicable) for the personnel attending capacity building or networking meets at the Assam Startup - The Nest.

5. Non Exclusivity

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be non-exclusive and both the parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries, and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind.

6. Validity and Termination

This MOU is for an initial period of 2 years and may be amended or terminated earlier by a mutually written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party.

7. Assignment

It is understood by the Parties herein that this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party, and hence, neither Party shall transfer or assign

Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Cooperation

The D.H.S.K. Commerce College and Sibsagar Commerce College recognize their strength in research and education in one or more disciplines of Humanities and Social Sciences and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

D.H.S.K. Commerce College and Sibsagar Commerce College, therefore, agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest and in accordance with the terms and condition set forth in this Memorandum of understanding (MoU).

Objectives

- 1.2.1 Gratia Technology Private Limited shall provide Industry relevant Training Programme in the domain of ICT, for the Teachers/Researchers/Students scholars
- 1.2.2 Gratia Technology Private Limited shall provide Industry relevant Training Programme for the students, at a nominal cost mutually agreed by both the parties
- 1.2.3 Gratia Technology Private Limited shall make its content accessible through a web portal for the teachers/researchers/Students of the institutions
- 1.2.4 Gratia Technology Private Limited would provide assistance in IT Research activities to the teachers by way of supervision and collaboration
- 1.3 D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam shall notify about the programme of Gratia Technology Private Limited to its departments and assist in the active participation of the teachers.
- 1.4 D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam shall provide the following infrastructure at its campus for some of the training programmes, workshops and conferences to be conducted by Gratia Technology Private Limited.
 - 1.4.1. Computer Lab infrastructure (Hardware, software and peripherals)
 - 1.4.2. Training room for conducting the training programmes
 - 1.4.3. Conference Hall/Seminar Hall/ Auditorium
 - 1.4.4. LCD projector and screen
- 1.5 The teachers/researchers/students of D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam would attend some special training programmes at Gratia Technology Private Limited Campus, Guwahati (If interested). Gratia Technology Private Limited shall provide necessary infrastructure for the conductance of the training programme.
- 1.6 D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam hereby undertakes that it shall not utilize the contents, training materials and such other information provided hereunder beyond the scope of this MOU and shall not share such information with any third parties without the consent of Gratia Technology Private Limited except for academic activities.
- 1.7 Gratia Technology Private Limited agrees to provide various domain specific training programmes to the teachers in the university and its colleges on regular basis.
- 1.8 Gratia Technology Private Limited shall bring industry certified trainers of the D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam on every programme conducted for the teachers/researches/students of the college.
- 1.9 Both the parties shall explore and jointly develop new course for the teachers from time to time the terms for the same will be discussed as and when required
- 1.10 Both the parties shall explore to work on specific ICT related research areas as per the industry requirement and agreed upon by both parties

2. Operation of this MOU

Upon execution of this MOU, Gratia Technology Private Limited shall communicate to D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam the training schedules. Thereupon, the parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms bases on which Gratia Technology Private Limited would offer its various other services.

3. Validity of this MOU

The validity of this MOU would be for five years from the date of the signing. The MOU may be renewed through a new MOU on completion of five years on such terms mutually agreed between the parties. Both parties shall have the right to terminate this MOU if any of the party does not comply with its obligations under this MOU by issuing 30 days prior notice.

4. Confidentiality

4.1 The parties shall treat all information, documents, contents and materials that are specifically declared as confidential pertaining to Gratia Technology Private Limited or D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam provided under this MOU as confidential.

4.2 Gratia Technology Private Limited or D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam shall not disclose any aspect of any confidential information to any third party in any manner whatsoever other in the normal course of agreed terms under this MOU.

4.3 The confidentiality of information shall survive until the termination of this Agreement.

5. Upon the termination of this MOU, D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam shall return all the contents, training materials and such other information provided by Gratia Technology Private Limited under this MOU duly without any undue delay and in cases where such information is not capable of being returned destroys the same and provide a certificate to that to Gratia Technology Private Limited.

6. Intellectual Property

All the Intellectual Property rights with respect to the programme contents provided by Gratia Technology Private Limited shall vest with Gratia Technology Private Limited and upon the termination of this agreement by efflux of time or such other earlier termination, D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam shall not have the right to use programmes, contents, and such other training materials installed under this MOU and return the same to Gratia Technology Private Limited.

7. Notices

All notices regarding this agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail postage prepaid or by courier, at the address as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner. Any such notices shall be



deemed received when actually delivered if personal delivery or three days after delivered to an overnight or express mail facility, if delivered through post.

8. Governing Law

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the law of the republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Guwahati/Dibrugarh.

9. Commercials

It is a Non Commercial MOU between Gratia Technology Private Limited and D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam. The College will provide the infrastructure and space to host the Faculty Development Programmes at their premises.

10. Arbitration

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between the parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this agreement either party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitrators, one to be appointed by Gratia Technology Private Limited, the other to be appointed by D. H. S. K. Commerce College, Dibrugarh, Assam and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties.

The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Guwahati.
