Introduction:

The concept of Gender Champions was initiated among the students of the College way back in 2018 when the then student members Pranab Jyoti Konwar (then GS) and Reshma Khanam (then Girls' Common Room Secretary) were verbally appointed as Gender Champions and asked to carry out gender sensitisation activities in their capacity of being student members of the ICC of the College.

The lockdown period in between kept the students at home so no activities were taken up in between. In December 2021, the next GS and Girls' Common Room Secretary, viz. Amrit Phukan and Arko Priya Sinha were inducted into the ICC as default student members and then as earlier, they were introduced to the concept of Gender Champions and their responsibilities as student members of the ICC.

In this manner, in the beginning, the ICC student members carried on the task of Gender Champions and though not in form mandated by the UGC, the tasks and responsibilities of the Gender Champions existed in the College under the banner of the ICC till September, 2022.

The process of selecting and appointing Gender Champions formally began by June 2022 and finally in September the formal inauguration of the Gender Champions Club (the first ever among the Colleges in Assam) of the College started the activities of the Champions. A total of 15 students were selected as Gender Champions and they were handed a badge and selection letter in the presence of the invited guest, Rituparna Neog, a noted gender activist and social worker.




