

## Summary report

Over the span of five academic years, a breakdown of student enrollments and course offerings is evident. In the 2018-19 academic year, a total of 45 students were enrolled in DCA course. The following year, 36 students participated in the educational offerings. However, during the 2020-21 academic years, no students were enrolled due to the widespread impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite this disruption, the institution resumed operations in the subsequent year, with 26 students joining the courses. The most recent academic year, 2022-23, experienced a surge in enrollment, attracting 49 students to participate in the educational programs. Number of add on courses have increased as Department Of Economics, English and Banking have started three new add on courses. Though enrollment figures fluctuated due to external factors, the institution demonstrated resilience by adapting to challenges and continuing to provide diverse courses to its students.
